



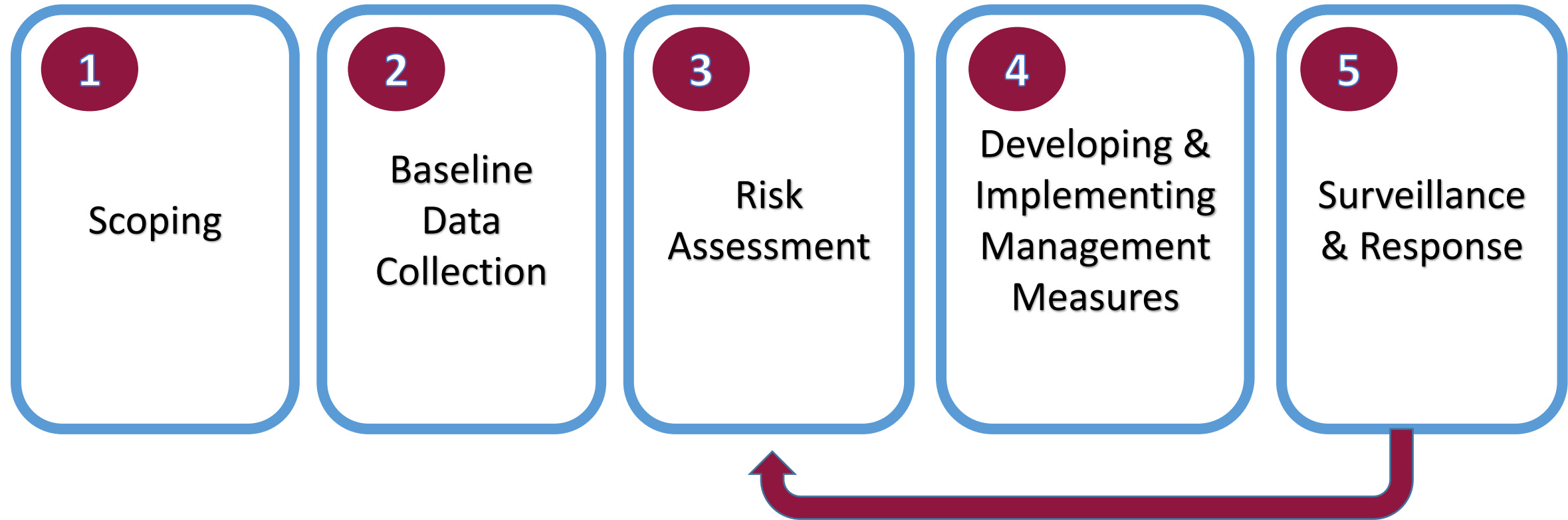

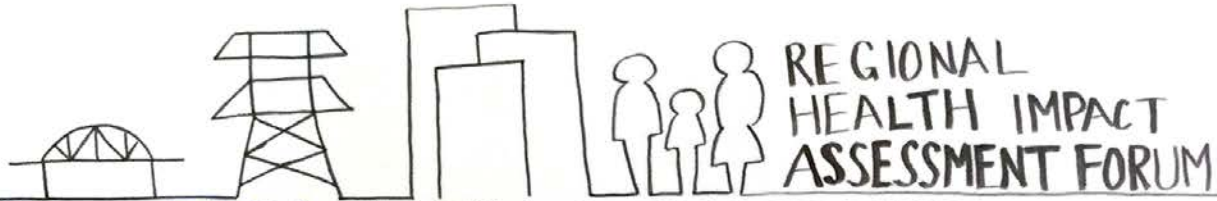

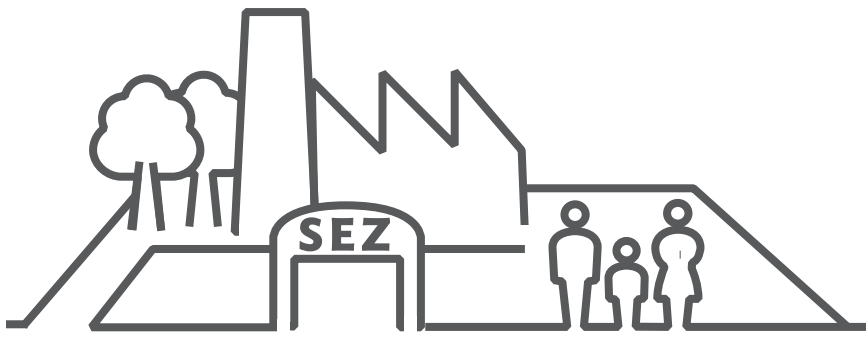
- Strengthening the health component in Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) – a regulatory requirement globally for all development activities.

- GMS HIA Framework for Special Economic Zones



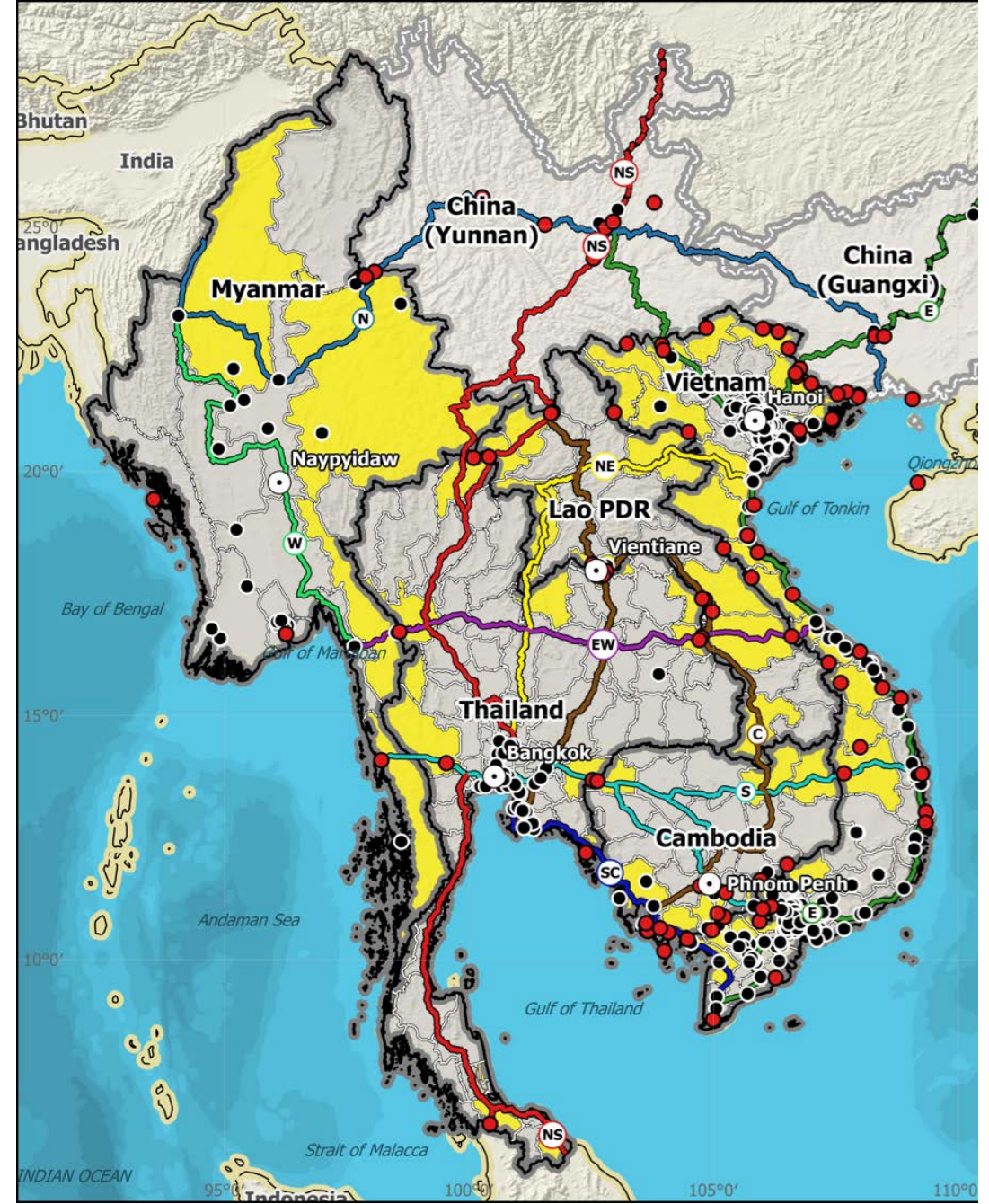
