

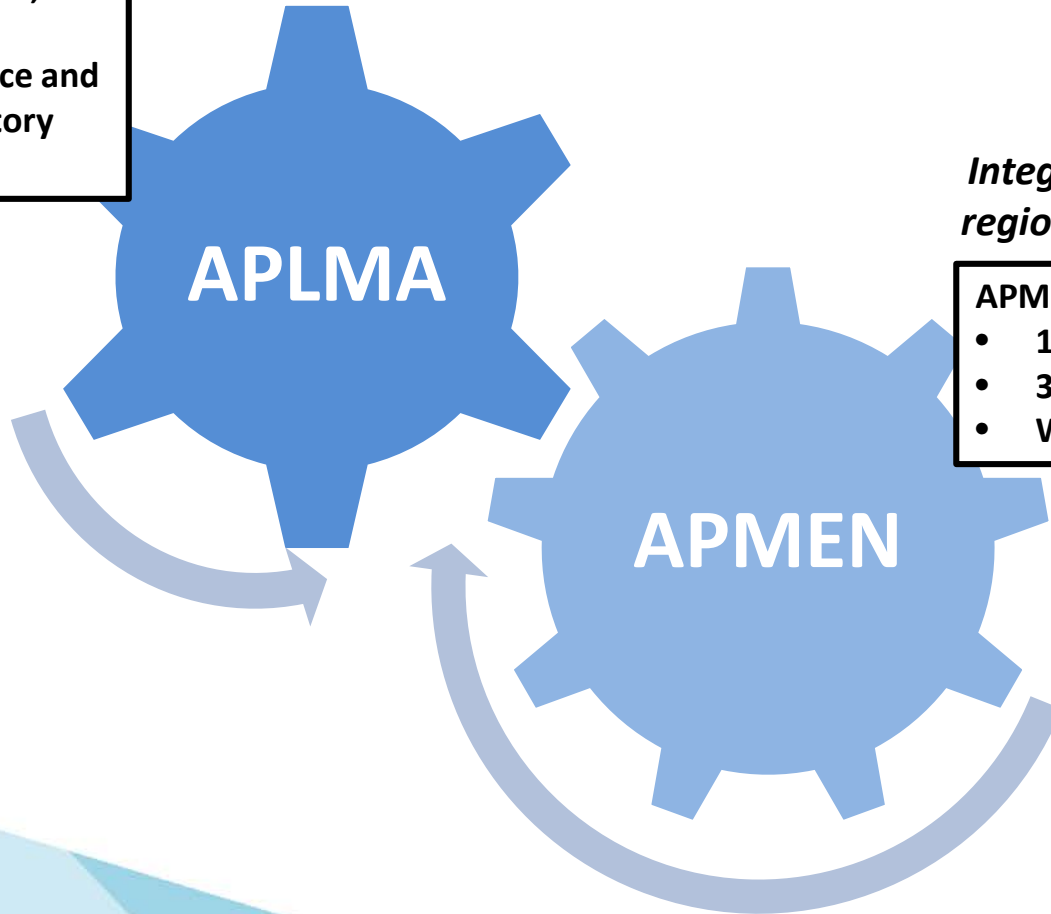

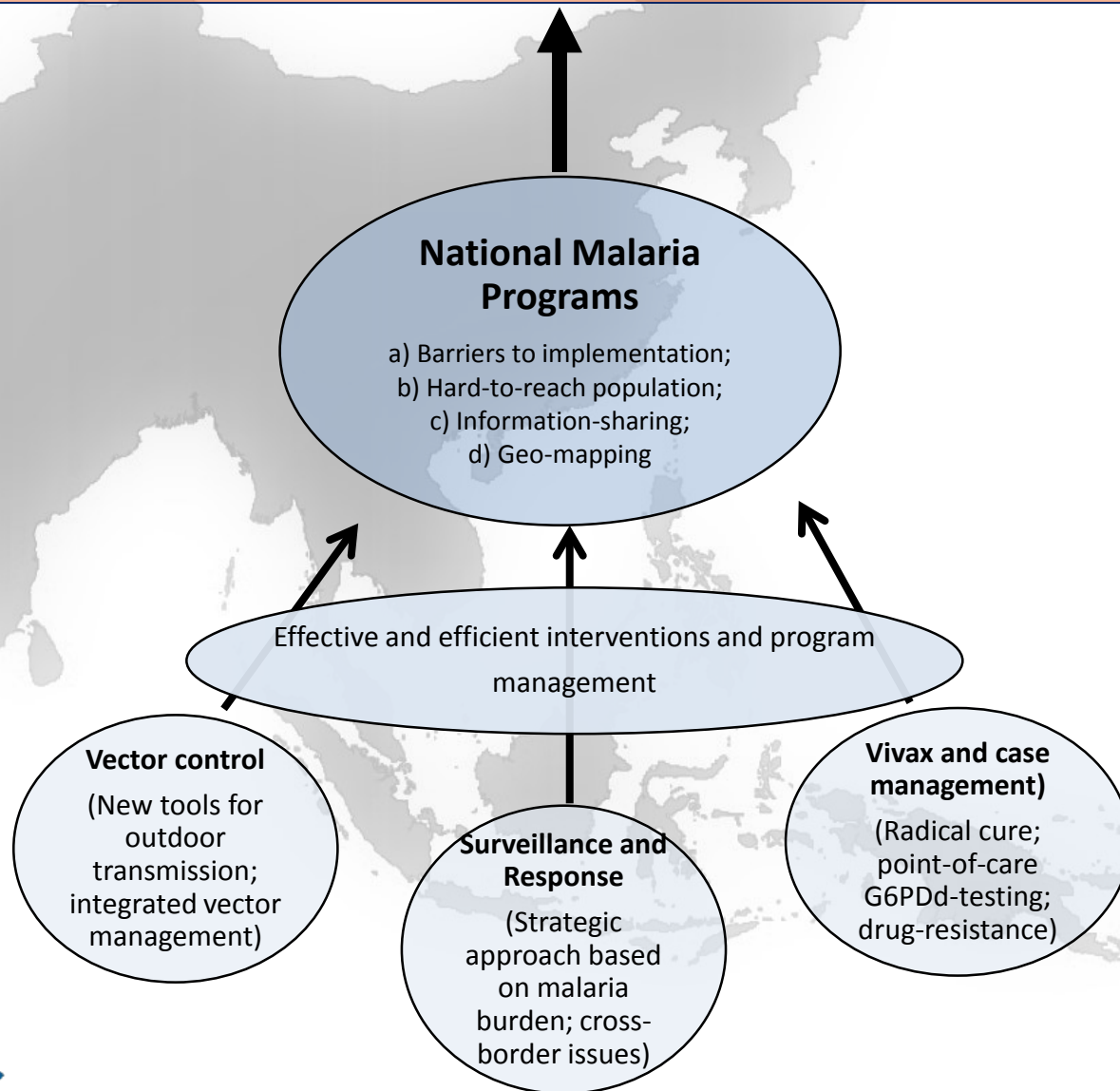
Objectives
